- Thrilled to have so much consistency among the staff. The school has only one new hire as a classroom teacher, and all the rest are returning teachers. Also been able to add in some great additional staff members in some of the specialist areas.
- If you weren't able to attend Back to School Night, the teachers and specialists are sending out their slide deck from their presentations which will give a little bit more information such as what their roles are and how you can reach them, which was added this year.
- Renovations are underway. Construction teams are removing all the tiles from the ceiling all around the building for the next phase, and getting everything prepped for starting the new two story building in the back and new cafeteria.
