- Standardized Testing:
 - Virginia Growth Assessment (VGA) testing has been completed. Students in grades 3-6 take a VGA test for reading and mathematics in the Fall and again in Winter. When the results for all students' VGA tests are returned to Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS), the division shares this information with families.
 - Some students grade 1-6 will be taking the iReady assessment. Families will only receive a report for a window when the student took the reading or mathematics iReady test.
 - Starting to assess for WIDA and WIDA Screeners which is an English Language Proficiency Assessment for ESL students.
- Construction Update:
 - Currently on Phase 2 Renovation of the current building then removal of modules (~March)
 - Phase 3 will begin after Spring Break and go throughout the Summer, and be completed by Fall 2024



- Students submitting drawings or cartoons must send scans of their work. We will treat them like pictures in the paper. (If you need help scanning, please let us know.)


