#### Principal's Report – Michelle Makrigiorgos & Jennifer Condra

- Construction / Renovation Presentation :
  - Nothing has changed from the original site plan (<u>https://louisearcherpta.org/wp-content/uploads/</u>2021/11/Louise-Archer-ES-PTA-presentation-21-1118.pdf)
  - o Timeline:
    - Phase 1 -
      - On schedule for new building additions & cafeteria/kitchen
      - As soon as summer begins construction crews will be renovating the gym, installing a new playground, and surfacing the blacktop to the right of the parking lot
      - To be completed by July/August 2023
    - Phase 2 -
      - Renovation of the current building then removal of modules (~February/March)
      - Note: The beginning of the 2023-2024 school year will mostly be in the new building addition as well as the modulars while the inside of the current building is being renovated.
      - To be completed February 2024
    - Phase 3 -
      - Renovations of front office and library
      - To be completed Summer 2024
      - Final Project Completion August 2024
  - o Survey Questions Answered:
    - Modular -
      - The modular will be in use by the 3rd grade until February
      - Removal of modular is expected in March
    - Cafeteria -
      - Probably a little bigger / layout is a similar
      - Lunch schedule is currently 10:45-2:00 and it will remain in that time frame so that its not overloaded/overcrowded and can still be used for other activities throughout the day.
    - Outdoor / Green Space -
      - The outdoor basketball courts, playground, and front tent space will all be renovated starting in the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year.
    - Tree Preservation -
      - Tree preservation was considered during the design phase and approved by the Town of Vienna and Arborist. Since that time, arborist and Fairfax County Officials have been looking at tree preservation (front & sides of building) and are developing a landscaping plan.
      - It is likely we will have to remove some unhealthy trees that are causing some concern.

- New Rooms -
  - Slightly larger classrooms, flexible seating opportunities, carpet space and less furniture to allow students more movement in the classrooms. And of course, the building is much larger therefore there will be much more movement in & between spaces.
- Administration meets with construction every other week so if you think of any other questions you'd like to ask, feel free to send them, and updates will be sent out during the end of the year.
- End of Year Testing :
  - o The week of June 12th the SOL scores will be posted to your ParentVue accounts.
  - o iReady will be posted to your ParentVue accounts -
    - Grade 1 & 2 : week of June 5th
    - Grade 3 through 6 : week of June 20th
  - o Kindergarten assessments will be delivered by mail in mid-July
  - WIDA results will be delivered by mail the week of June 12th

  - Azura Fund a little over budget so the executive board bumped the budget line up to \$500.
  - Mini Grants \$528 over budget so the PTA is asking for a vote tonight to increase to \$1,000 which will make the bring the new budget to \$13,000. Any funds leftover will be rolled into next school year's school supply closet fund)
