Principal's Report

- Happy New Year!
- There will be a virtual school day tomorrow (Jan. 19) due to weather. The school day will start at 10:30 am and go until 1:15 pm due to the scheduled early release. All kids will have lunch at the same time, which will hopefully help if multiple kids are at home. All grades will also have one special. The school has been working on possible schedules and is hopeful the current schedule will work out.

 - Everyone is looking forward to next Tuesday and a return to the regular schedule.
- The end of the quarter is Friday, Jan. 21. Thank you to parents for rolling with the schedule in 2022.
- The school continues to use layered prevention strategies for covid. There have been some, but a minimal number of cases the past week. The teachers are working hard to maintain instruction and mitigation. Thank you to parents for all of the communication, which helps make it successful and smooth as possible
- There is some specialized testing coming up, such as the advanced math Iowa test. The SOL testing may be a little earlier this year, possibly the week right before Memorial Day. The schedule is coming soon.

Treasurer's Report

- In November and December, the PTA received \$760 in donations and memberships
- We paid \$341 in local and state membership dues
- Apart from before and after school activities, we raised \$5,749 in November and December, bringing the net fundraising income to \$13,566. The fundraising income included
 - o \$1,229 in dining for dollars from Social burger and Mama Tigre

- \$4500 in rewards from the Safeway Foundation, Amazon, Scrip rebates, and Harris Teeter
- As for the PTA expenses for November and December, apart from the fall school activities, we paid
 - \$40 from the Azzara fund for 1st grade T-shirts
 - o \$747 for Reflections ceremony
 - o \$316 for LA5K
 - o \$497 for teacher classroom support
 - o \$4,546 in mini grants (Sarah will give more details later)
 - o \$61 for teacher pop-up party, and
 - o \$45 for paypal fees
- Our cash at the end of December was \$54,116
