Principal's Report

Treasurer's Report

- In April, we raised
 - \$105 from Dining for Dollars at Plaka Grill
 - About \$2000 from Original Works

- And \$460 from our Bundt cake sales for Pizza Bingo, and
- \$1,990 in 6th grade celebration ticket sales and donations
- As for expenses, we paid
 - \$624 to Papa Johns for Pizza Bingo,
 - \$117 for field day bounce house rental,
 - \$84 for clay club
 - About \$25,000 for before and after school sports and games
 - \$269 for science Olympiad
 - \$1,278 for Learning AtoZ subscription renewal
 - \$96 for mentoring luncheon
 - \$140 in classroom supplies
 - \$230 for mini grants
 - \$90 for bank and paypal fees
 - And \$22.50 for website hosting
- The PTA cash balance at the end of April was \$54,561
